All 4-H exhibits must be prepared and entered according to County and State Fair guidelines. The 4-H member should enter the class that matches his or her grade as of Sept. 1 of 4-H year. If youth is in 3rd grade they must be 8 years old before Sept. 1.

- Simple Tops & Costume
- Simple Bottoms & Costume
- Non-human Apparel (Doll clothes, pet or livestock garment & costume)
- Sewn Fashion Accessory (Sewn hats, scarves, bag, wallet, purse, string-pack or textile based jewelry.)
- Knitted/Crocheted Yarn/Thread Fashion Accessory (knitted/crocheted hats, scarves, bag, wallet, string-pack, or textile based jewelry.)

Required to leave skill mastery sheet attached.

Level 2 (Grades 5-6)

- One piece garment with facing
- Simple Bottom with pocket and/or waistband or facing
- Two piece garment (top and bottom, jacket/vest with bottom/dress, PJs)
- Non-human Apparel (doll clothes, pet or livestock garment)
- Sewn Fashion Accessory (sewn hats, scarves, bag, wallet, string-pack, or textile based jewelry)
- Knitted/Crocheted Yarn/Thread Fashion Accessory (knitted/crocheted hats, scarves, bag, wallet, string-pack, or textile based jewelry)
- Lined or unlined 1 piece garment with facing

Level 3 (Grades 7-8)

- Blouse/Shirt with sleeves and closure (set-in, flat inset, cap, raglan, or kimono)
- Bottom with zipper and/or pocket (shorts, capris, pants, skirts)
- Two piece garment (coordinating top and bottom, jacket/vest with bottom/dress, PJs, uniform)
- One piece garment with buttonholes and/or zipper (shirt, blouse, robe, jacket, vest, dress, jumpsuit, costume, uniform)
- Sewn Fashion Accessory (With closure/fastener and seams)
- Knitted/Crocheted Yarn/Thread Fashion Garment or Accessory (Knitted, crocheted, or tatted)
- Costume human or non-human (dance pageant, holiday, theatrical, reenactment/period/living history garments)

Level 4 (Grades 9-12)

- One piece lined or unlined, garment (pants, skirt, coat, jacket, dress, jumpsuit, uniform, formalwear)
- Unlined two piece ensemble/coordinate
- Lined two piece ensemble/coordinate or costume (coat/jacket/vest, dress, or suit)
- Fashion Accessory or Garment designed for Special Needs. "Special Needs" being the individual requirements of a person with a mental, emotional, physical disability or disease.
- Fashion garment or accessory

4-H FOOD

Units are to be on a paper plate & securely wrapped with clear wrapping or plastic bag. Enter a maximum of 1 item per class per each year of work.

Level Two - Grades 3-5

- Three (3) Muffins
- Three (3) Rolled Biscuits
- Three (3) Baked Drop Cookies (no shaped cookies such as snickerdoodle or peanut butter)
- One-half loaf of any yeast bread (not sweet dough) made by hand or in a bread machine
- Three (3) yeast cinnamon rolls (no icing)
- Three (3) rolled sugar-type cookies (no gingerbread recipes)
- One half loaf or portion of breads from another culture. Include a one page story on how this bread fits into that culture and its nutritional contribution.
- One-half of one 8" layer Un-iced shorten type cake (no angel food or chiffon)

Level Three - Grades 6-8

- One pint or half pint jar of jam or jelly processed in boiling water canner
- Two pieces of fruit leather
- One pint or half pint of salsa/picante sauce

Level Four - Grades 9-12

- One pint jar cucumber pickles or vegetable relish
- One pint or quart of a single canned fruit (not pickled).
- Dried Fruit (1/2 cup of a single dried fruit). Display in a sealed sandwich /freezer bag.

Grades 9-12

- One pint or quart jar pressure canned vegetables (no tomatoes or pickles)
- One quart or one pint jar of plain canned tomatoes.

FOOD PRESERVATION EXHIBITS

Jar rings should be left on for display. Home canned food entries to be presented in standard jars made for home canning, and sealed.

Grade 3-5

- One pint or half pint jar of jam or jelly processed in boiling water canner
- Two pieces of fruit leather

- One pint jar cucumber pickles or vegetable relish

- All entries are free but no unworthy entry will be received.
- All entries must be in the exhibit building by 5 p.m., Thursday, unless otherwise stated, and remain in place until released by Superintendents beginning on Saturday, at 8 a.m. and closing at 10 a.m. Premiums will also be paid at this time. Exhibits left after 10 a.m. will be at the risk of the exhibitor.
- The Exhibit Building will be cleared of all spectators and locked when entries close at 5 p.m., Thursday, during the judging of all exhibits. The building will be re-opened to the public immediately after the judging is completed.
- All Premiums will be forfeited if NOT PICKED UP by 10 A.M. Saturday.
- All property entered at the Fair shall be subject to the control of the Secretary or the Superintendent in charge.
- Separate exhibits must be provided for each entry in each class except livestock. Individual ownership must be established if more than one entry in any class is made from the same farm or home.
- Entry forms will be provided for listing of all entries and exhibitors are required to see that their exhibits are properly listed on same.
- All livestock will be released at the conclusion of their respective shows.
